Extracurricular activities/fieldtrips: There are over 50 extracurricular activities available to join, offered during lunch and after school, including Intramurals (sports), Yearbook Committee, Games Room, Oasis Lounge, Art Club, Grad Committee, Blue and Gold, Student Council, Theatre Productions, Fitness Room, Science Fair, Robotics, Variety Show, Strategy Games Club, Plant Club, Multicultural Club, Web Site Development, Community Involvement, Graduation Committee, School band, and much more. Several field trips occur throughout the school year: Boston, New York, Europe, Huntsman Marine Science Centre, Tubing trip (sliding on the snow in the mountains) and more.

Core courses: All students are offered regular or enriched: English Language Arts, Mathematics, French as a Second Language, Science and Technology, Social Studies, (History; available in French for students in the French Plus program), Ethics and Religious Culture, Physical Education and Arts (Visual Art, Drama or Music).

Elective courses: There are many elective courses offered over the three years, such as Yoga Fitness, 2D Mixed Media Arts, Introduction to computer APPS & Coding, Sculpture, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Psychology and Criminology, Leadership

Concentration programs: These offer students the opportunity to pursue their passion in the Arts or Sports by delving more deeply in their field of interest. These programs provide students with the opportunity to complete the regular or enriched academic program while benefitting from more time to focus on skill development in their chosen concentration.
